- You can purchase a discounted pass for the duration of the event, providing unlimited travel on the tram network.
- Please buy your tram pass before arrival [here](#)
- Your Team Liaison Officer will arrange how to get your passes to you prior to arrival at the Hockey Centre

Useful Info

- The NET tram runs regularly between the City Centre and the Hockey Centre with trams every 7 minutes during the week and from every 10 minutes at weekends and bank holidays.
- Attendees at the Hockey Masters will need to use the Hucknall – Toton Lane line.
- The closest tram stop to the Hockey Centre is the University of Nottingham stop. The Nottingham Hockey Centre is then a 2min walk.
